

# TOUR OF MARITIME ROTTERDAM

## FOR THE TEACHER

### Before you start

Split the class up beforehand into groups of about four pupils. Make sure that at least one pupil in each group has a smartphone. Get the pupils to download the walking tour beforehand. That can be done free of charge at home or at school by Wi-Fi. If it is not possible to organise that, it can also be done using Wi-Fi in the museum's entrance lobby, although that will add some delay, of course.

### Group size

Maximum 30 pupils per walking group. If the group is bigger than thirty, split the class into two groups and have one group do the walk in the reverse direction. The second group then starts at the end, beginning at no. 35, Witte de Withstraat. The walk on your phone adjusts automatically.

### Downloading

The pupil surfs to their app store and installs IZI Travel - Cityguides. After installing, they search for the **Rotterdam Round Trip** tour, and then click it and download it. The questions, photos and videos are then pre-downloaded via Wi-Fi (so they do not have to be streamed outside). Once that has been done, the tour can start at any time. Note that the location features in Settings must be ON!

### Upon arrival

Check in at the entrance desk while the pupils wait outside for a moment. You can tell us the number of pupils and supervisors.

### Outside

A digital map on the smartphone then tells you which way to go (6.3 km), beginning at the starting point behind the museum. The route lets the pupils experience both the port and the metropolis. The following are featured: the bombed-out Waterkwartier, a spectacular view from the Erasmus Bridge, a walk along the River Maas, the history of the migration companies on Wilhelmina Pier, a view of the Veerhaven, an adventurous trip by water taxi and finally an introduction to trendy Witte de Withstraat. *Crossing to Veerhaven by water taxi is well worth doing, but it is **NOT** free of charge. You need to reserve this yourself on +31 (0)10-4030303 Regarding the boarding time: you get to the boarding point next to Hotel New York after about 45-60 minutes after starting out from the Maritime Museum.*

Make sure that the phones are fully charged. GPS (free of charge) is used during the walk; this uses a fair amount of energy.

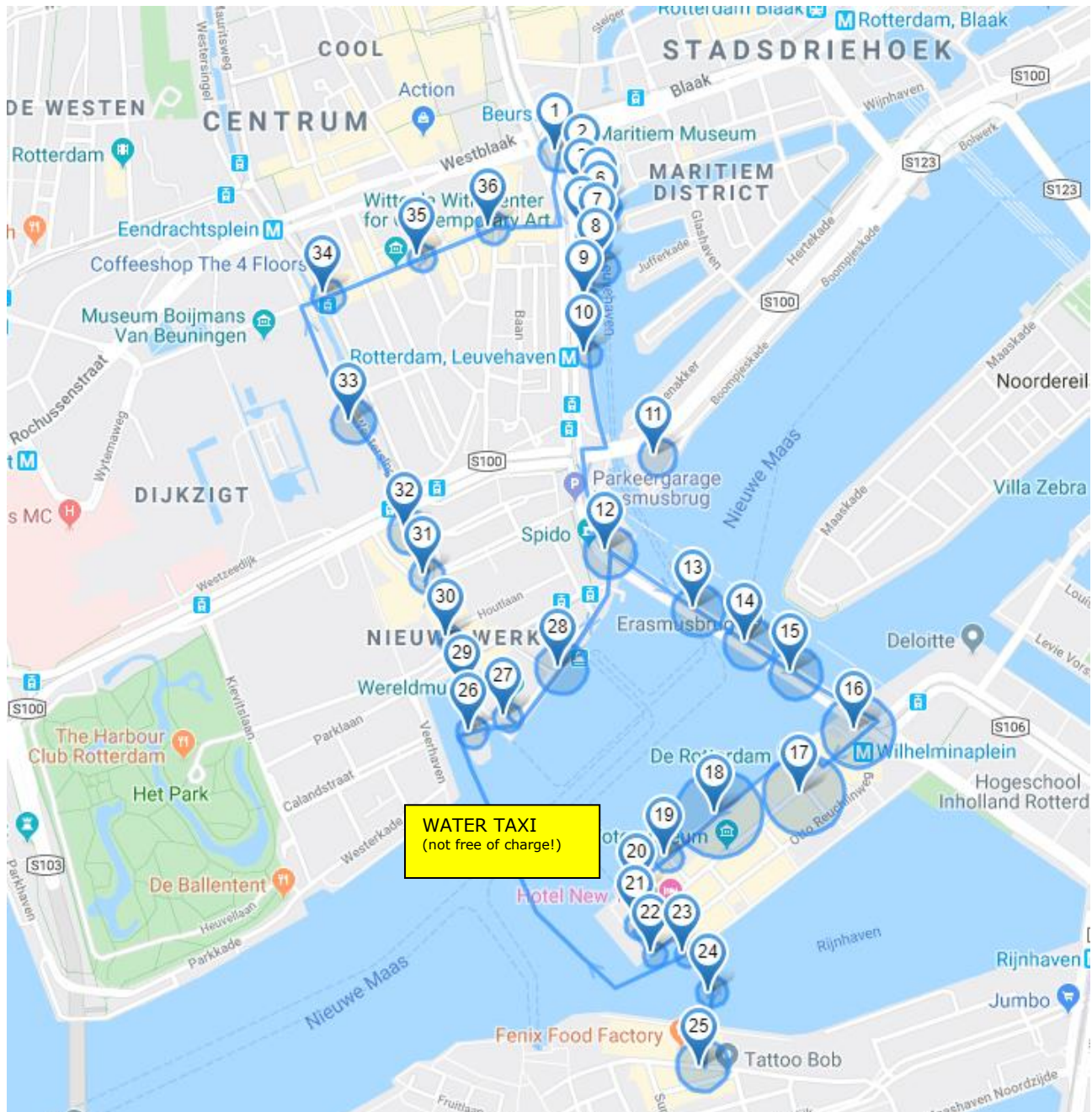
